AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S NUISANCE
ABATEMENT ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 400, TO AMEND
THE DEFINITION OF JUNK IN SECTION 29 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS

1. The City has determined that the Nuisance Abatement Ordinance, in Section 29, the definition junk is incomplete. It needs to be updated.
2. As required by the City Charter, the City has posted the notice in prominent places about the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City hereby does ordain:

Item 1: SECTION 29. JUNK A. The definition of junk is amended to read: The term "junk" as used in this section includes, but is not limited to, all old motor vehicles, old motor vehicle parts, abandoned autos, old machinery or machinery parts, discarded appliances or appliance parts, old iron or other metal, glass, paper, lumber, wood, or other discarded material. For the purposes of this subsection, the term "old" shall also include, but is not limited to items that are dilapidated, abandoned, inoperable, including: "a motor vehicle without current state licensing and/or otherwise in a visible state of disrepair".

Paragraphs B and C of Section 29 remain unchanged.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE

This ordinance being enacted by the Common Council in the exercise of its police power and for the purpose of meeting an emergency, and being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon being enacted.
